Troy Fair Princess Rules and Requirements

About the Troy Fair Princess Contest

New this year the Troy Fair Princess Contest is a FUN contest to help get the younger generation involved in the Troy Fair, and is hosted by the Troy Fair Jr Board in conjunction with the Troy Fair Queen Program. The contest will take part of Kids Day at the Troy Fair on Saturday July 28th 2018. This year's Kids Day theme is "A Troy Fair-y Tale" and will star our Princess Contest as well as many local organizations, free bicycle helmets, and a raffle of two bicycles! The contest will crown one Princess to represent the Troy Fair alongside the Troy Fair Queens for the remainder of the day/fair on Saturday.

The qualifications for Troy Fair Princess are as follows:

1. Female, Pennsylvania resident and U.S. Citizen.
2. Live in or attend a school in Bradford County.
3. Be at least 5 years old before June 1st, 2018 and not over 9 years old by June 1st, 2018.
4. She must have parent's or guardian's consent.
5. Must be of good moral character (at discretion of the Troy Fair Board).
6. Have some agriculture knowledge and an interest in promoting the Troy Fair.
7. Not be a current title/pageant winner for any other commodity.
8. Must meet all time commitments, Princess obligations, and dress code established by the Troy Fair Board.

Dress Code

Young ladies are asked to wear a nice summer dress for crowning and interview.

Areas of Competition

All young ladies will compete in the following areas of competition and will be judged by a panel of judges.

1. Application
2. Interview – 5 minutes
3. On-Stage Question – will be age appropriate and fair or bio related.
4. Poise and Presence throughout the day

This is a FUN contest! The purpose of this contest is to promote interest of the Troy Fair in younger generations. There will be no further participation nor competition after Saturday July 28th 2018 required

Duties of Troy Fair Princess

Spend the remainder of the fair/day (Saturday July 28th 2018) at the Troy Fair. During that day the Princess will assist the Troy Fair Queens Court in their duties of announcements, greeting fair goers and entertainment, and passing out tootsie rolls! She will also assist in activities of Kids Day under the Big Tent in the Lower Meadow.
