HEALTH REGULATIONS

1. Equines shall be required to have negative Coggins papers dated within twelve months of the date of the horse show. Any horse under 6 months of age does not require Coggins papers.
2. **Proof of rabies vaccination is mandatory. Please bring a COPY of rabies certificate.** Show committee also recommends a 4-way shot for horses who will be at any horse show in close proximity to other horses.
3. No equines showing evidence of any contagious or infectious disease will be permitted entry to the fair. We would like to keep this a fun healthy show day!

HORSE SHOW RULES

1. Only serviceably sound horses will be entitled to be judged.
2. The Fair Show Committee reserves the right to refuse any or all entries if needed.
3. Halter classes will be combined to result in the judging of mixed breeds.
4. Horses' ages shall be computed according to their actual age the date of show.
5. All horses must be under full control at all times or leave the fairgrounds at the discretion of the Fair Horse Show Committee. Exhibitors are expected to be ready to enter the ring at the final call for their class; to follow the lead of the ring steward; and to refrain from conversation with the judge unless answering questions or making acknowledgments.
6. Stallions may not be taken in hand, under saddle, or in hitch, by any youth.
7. **Judging is to begin at 10 AM. Any changes in Halter Classes must be made by 9 AM. Any changes in hitch classes must be made at least two classes before the class wanted changed.**
8. **In Case of Pre-Registration:** (Highly Recommended) Entry Fee of \$5 per class. Pre entries must be in by July 20, 2017. Please mail entries to Tricia Hojnowski, 3547 Minnequa Main Rd., Canton, PA 17724.

Directions: The Troy Fairgrounds are located along Route 14, just north of Troy, PA.

Exhibitors Must Enter And Use Only Gate 3, the northernmost entry point. The horse show complex is located at the northern end of the fairgrounds. Proceed through Gate 3, and bear right after the row of barns. Parking for rigs will be designated. Box stalls available near the show Ring first come first serve. **PLEASE CLEAN STALLS AFTER USE. Stalls that are not cleaned at the conclusion of the show will not be refunded.**
