4-H / FFA Breeding Rabbit Show

The 4-H/FFA Market Rabbit Show will be held on Monday, July 22 at 6:30 P.M. in the small arena or rabbit barn. The 4-H/FFA Breeding Rabbit Show will be held on Saturday, July 27 starting at 9:00 A.M in the small arena. Entry forms have been included-they are due at the Extension Office on June 1, 2019. Any Clover buds who want to participate, please fill out an entry with the name of the rabbit you will be using. (not required to use this rabbit if circumstances change) Rabbits will be on display and cared for by barn manager all week at the fair, Please indicate number of cages you require. Drop off time Sunday 3-8pm or Monday 8:00 am- 1:00. Contact person Linda Elsbree, 570-905-0923. Volunteers for watching Rabbit barn needed, please indicate days and times available on entry forms. Passes will be provided.

Ethics and Quality Assurance Training

Ethics and quality assurance training is required by all 4-H animal project members. If members do not complete this training by July 1, 2019, they will not be able to show.

All completed projects are due at the Fairgrounds on Saturday, July 13 by 2:00pm if you plan to interview at Round- up. If you do not plan to interview books are due in the Extension Office on Thursday, July 11 at 5 p.m. If your books are not turned in on time, you will not be eligible to show your project at 4-H Roundup.

You will need to complete all requirements for the breeding/pet or market rabbit project. Cavy for cavy members.

Members must complete:

1. *Record book*
2. *Activity Book*
3. *Poster/ presented to club date included*

All completed projects are due at the Fairgrounds on Saturday, July 13 by 2:00 P.M. or at the Extension Office by 12:00 P.M. on Friday, July 12th.

If your books are not turned in on time, you will not be eligible to show your project at 4-H Roundup.

If you want to know how you will be judged there are score sheets in the 4-H room at the Extension Office and your leader will also have these score sheets.

You must turn in your project books by 2:00 P.M. on Saturday, July 13th at the 4-H building and you also must receive at least a white ribbon on your project in order to

show. * Note, missing whole sections counts as a zero and costs you all the points for that section.

A Gate Pass Form has been included in your packet. You need to send this to Troy Fair. As a 4-H or FFA **Market Rabbit** exhibitor you are entitled to free passes for Monday and \$1.00 passes for 2 family members. As a 4-H or FFA **Breeding Rabbit** exhibitor you are entitled to free passes for Friday and Saturday and \$1.00 passes for 2 family members.

All rabbits need to arrive and be checked in for the week on Sunday between the hours of 3:00 - 8:00 P.M. or Monday between the hours of 8:00 A.M. and 5:00 P.M. – Cloverbuds and those breeding rabbits who we may not have room for, will come day of Breed Show between 8:00- 9:00 a.m. on Saturday, July 27. **All rabbits will need to stay until 5:00 p.m. on Saturday, July 27, 2019.** (excluding Market Rabbits and cloverbuds) All rabbits must leave between 5:00 and 7:00. Cloverbuds are welcome to bring rabbits for a special Cloverbud class and showmanship class. There will be no placing of Cloverbuds.

Show Rules.

1. **All rabbits must be owned by the exhibitor by May 15, 2019. All entries are due at the Extension Office by June 1, 2019.**
2. All carriers must have a leak-proof bottom.
3. All rabbits must have a permanent mark in the left ear. Excluding clover buds and cavies.
4. All 4-H/FFA rabbit exhibitors must wear a long sleeve shirt or a show jacket. There will be no open toed shoes allowed.

3. Club Herd –Each participant from each club brings in 1 rabbit of choice (Rosettes).

 - a. Junior (8 -11)
 - b. Intermediate (12-14)
 - c. Senior (15 and over)
 - d. Cloverbud 5-8 participation ribbons
5. Costume Contest (Trophy)
6. Rabbit Jumping Contest (Rosettes)

All rabbit exhibitors need to fill out and sign an Animal Owner or Caretaker’s Verification of Veterinarian-Client-Patient Relationship form. This form will need to be presented upon arrival at the Fairgrounds. It is on bottom of your Entry form! Sign it!!

Market Meat Rabbit Show for meat rabbit pens will be held on Monday, July 22 at 6:30 P.M. in the small arena. Meat rabbit pens can arrive no later than 6:00 P.M. in the Small Arena. Pens of meat rabbits will sell during the 4-H/FFA Livestock Sale on Wednesday, July 24th.

Meat Rabbit Pen, all same breed and variety, not over 10 weeks, 3 to 5 pounds weight each rabbit.

For meat rabbit exhibitors

1. Bring meat pens in trios.
2. The sexes of your 3 meat rabbits can be mixed.
3. Meat rabbits will be weighed in at 6:00 before the Market Rabbit Show.
4. 2 Meat Pens may be shown per exhibitor but only 1 may be sold unless receiving both Grand and Reserve Champion honors

Pennsylvania Requirements:

1. An *Animal Owner or Caretaker’s Verification of Veterinarian-Client-Patient Relationship* (VCPR) form must accompany all PA rabbits, and must be presented upon arrival at the exhibition.
2. All animals must be free of infectious and contagious diseases.

Out of State Requirements:

1. A Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI) issued within the 60 days prior to the opening day of exhibition is required.

2. All animals must be free of infectious and contagious diseases and a statement of this is required on the CVI (the statement is pre-printed on the CVI).
3. An *Animal Owner or Caretaker's Verification of Veterinarian-Client-Patient Relationship* (VCPR) statement for the animals being exhibited must be included on the fair registration form.
