

PLEASE READ THIS BEFORE COMPLETING GATE PASS ORDER FORM

Section 1: Exhibitor Information

If animals are leased, use a separate order form for each family who is leasing. Write farm name (ex: John Doe Holsteins).

List each exhibitor's name, quantity of animals entered, and *type* of animal entered (ex: Jane Doe, 2, Holsteins). Write parent/contact information.

Section 2: Pass Policy

Youth Show – Each child showing an animal is entitled to one FREE pass for each day they are showing. If they are showing more than one type of animal on the same show day, they are only entitled to ONE free pass for that day. For example, if an exhibitor is showing market beef and swine both showing on Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday, they are only entitled to 3 free passes total.

Open Show – The same applies as Youth Show, but the free pass is per farm/family, not per son.

\$1 Passes – Refer to the pass policy section to see how many \$1.00 passes you are entitled to purchase. (ex: one exhibitor is showing 4 cows in the youth dairy show. They are entitled to one free pass for Monday, one free pass for Tuesday, and they can purchase 2 passes at \$1.00 each for Monday and 2 passes at \$1.00 each for Tuesday. The check amount would be \$4.00)

Section 3: Additional Gate Admission/Show Tickets

A Troy Fair brochure is included with your packet. You can purchase the pay-one-price gate admission for \$8.00 or a weekly pass with rides for \$40.00. This is a <u>pre-sale</u> price which includes gate admission, all mechanical rides, and all the free entertainment (it does not include grandstand shows). If you are a non-rider and do not qualify for the discounted Youth Show passes, you may purchase a PRE-SALE ONLY daily non-riding gate pass for \$6.00 or a weekly pass for \$25.00 They can be purchased with the enclosed brochure, at the Troy Fair office, by phone, or on-line at <u>www.troyfair.com</u>. For the passes received through the Youth Show program you will be able to buy a ride upgrade for only \$6.00 per day which will allow you to ride all the mechanical rides and the fun house. If you are ordering gate passes with your Agricultural Gate Pass Order Form, enclose one check for the Agricultural Gate Passes and one check for the additional gate/show tickets.

Anyone qualifying for a weekly pass or 3-day passes (Mon-wed) or (Thru-Sat) will get a wrist band versus a paper pass, the wrist band must be put on at the fair office the weekend before the fair.

Section 4: Mailing Information

You *must* include a self-addressed, stamped return envelope if you want the passes and tickets mailed to you. If not, the passes will be held in the Troy Fair office for you to pick up beginning July 12 through Sunday, July 24. You must have your passes prior to the fair to be admitted, or you will have to pay at the gate, and you will not be reimbursed.

SECTION 2

PASS POLICY

Youth Show - <u>1 free pass per child/per day</u> showing an animal for each day the animal is required to be at the fair (see chart on reverse side for days).

Open Show – <u>1 free pass per farm/family/per day</u>, not per person.

Anyone qualifying for a weekly pass will get a wrist band for the week instead of a paper pass. Anyone qualifying for a 3 day (Mon-Wed) or (Thurs-Sat) will also have a different color wrist band. The wrist band needs to be put on at the fair office the weekend before the fair Anyone qualifying for Thursday- Sat wrist band can come to fair office Wed or arrangements will be made at Gate 3 on Thursday.

Other passes may be purchased for \$1.00 per day for the eligible days as follows:

LARGE ANIMALS (cows, sheep, beef, goats, swine): 1-4 animals – 2 passes per day

5-9 animals – 3 passes per day 10 or more – 4 passes per day oultry): 1 pass per day

SMALL ANIMALS (pets, rabbits, poultry): Rabbits are based on per pen, not per rabbit.

SECTION 3 Troy Fair Pay One Price Gate - \$8.00 – This includes gate admission, all mechanical rides, the fun house and all the free

entertainment. For the passes received through the Youth Show program you will be able to buy a ride upgrade for only \$6.00 per day which will allow you to ride all the mechanical rides and the fun house. The weekly entry and ride pass is \$40.00, which includes all rides. The weekly entry pass without rides is \$25.00. If you wish to purchase additional gate or show tickets, please send one check for gate/show tickets and one check for Youth Show passes. Details can be found at troyfair.com.

If you are showing large animals (cows, sheep, beef, goat, swine) you can purchase the following number of passes needed for help with the animals for \$1.00 each:

1-4 large animals: 2 passes per day

5-9 large animals: 3 passes per day

10 or more large animals: 4 passes per day

If you are showing small animals (pets, rabbits, poultry) you can purchase 1 pass per day.

Rabbits are based on per pen, not per rabbit.

If show days overlap, you are only entitled to one set of passes.
