### Hay

1. Long hay only. An exhibit shall consist of a bale section at least 8” thick or an equivalent amount if cut from hay in the mow.
2. Display in plastic bags- white or clear preferred.

Class 1211: Alfalfa or alfalfa grass mixed, first cutting, not over 50% grasses

Class 1212: Alfalfa or alfalfa grass mixed, later cuttings, not over 50% of grasses

Class 1213: Other legumes or legume grass mixture, not over 50% of grasses

Class 1214: Grass, first cutting. Mixture of timothy and/or other grasses and containing not more than 10% legumes

Class 1215: Grass, second cutting. Mixtures of timothy and/or other grasses and containing no more than 10% legumes

Class 1216: Mixed hay, any mixture not classified in the previous classes, but which contains 50% or more singly or in a combination of alfalfa, timothy, clover and grasses

Class 1217: Alfalfa with not over 10% of grasses, first cutting

Class 1218: Alfalfa with not over 10% of grasses, later cuttings

Class 1219: Clover with not over 20% of timothy or other grasses

Class 1220: Clover-timothy mixed a mixture of clover and timothy with over 20% but less than 50% of timothy

Class 1221: Summer annual grasses-sudan grass sorghum, sudan, hybrids, etc.

### Silage

Silage-Crop must be named. Exhibits shall consist of 10 pounds. (Large size plastic bags are excellent containers for transporting or showing samples – preferable clear bags)

Class 1222: High Moisture Corn-Whole Shelled

Class 1223: High Moisture Corn- Ground Ear

Class 1224: Baleage- Small Grain

Class 1225: Baleage- Grass

Class 1226: Baleage- Legume

## **Small Grain**

Grain to be displayed in clear glass quart jars with lids or 1 gallon clear plastic ziplock bags.

Class 1201: Barley

Class 1202: Oats

Class 1203: Wheat

Class 1204: Rye

Class 1205: Buckwheat

Class 1206: Sunflower

Class 1207: Soybean
